Department of Biomedical Engineering Undergraduate Research Internship Programme

I. <u>The Objective</u>

The Undergraduate Research Internship Programme provides an opportunity for full-time BME undergraduate students to engage in research activities under the supervision of our professors. This programme aims to enhance students' exposure and awareness towards emerging R&D topics that are important to their lifelong learning and future career development in industry or academic sectors.

II. <u>The Learning Outcome</u>

- (1) able to analysis problems in a logical manner
- (2) able to apply and gain knowledge in the process of solving problems

III. <u>The Scheme</u>

- (1) Undergraduate students with a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or above are eligible to apply (Final Year students are NOT allowed to join the programme during the summer).
- (2) The scheme is for BME undergraduate students who have a specific interest to conduct research activities. Students will join on voluntary basis, and currently NO academic credits have been allocated.
- (3) Each applicant will need to first approach a professor to consolidate a research title before submitting an application.
- (4) It is expected that the student will be attached to a professor/research laboratory. Prior approval/agreement for such attachment should be obtained by the student.
- (5) The level of remuneration may vary because of the nature and level of commitment of the internship. As a guideline, the stipend should have a maximum of HK\$2,500 per month.
- (6) Within two weeks after completion of the internship, each student is required to submit a 10-page final report.
- (7) A letter of completion will be issued to students who have completed the internship.

IV. <u>Recognition</u>

Students have completed not less than 8 weeks of full-time internship approved by the Department will eligible to take ENGG1820 Engineering Internship (1-unit).

V. Selection and Administrative Procedures

- (1) Professors will review the students' application and select student(s).
- (2) Professors will review the students' final report and provide feedback to students.
- (3) The General Office will assist in the administration of the programme.
