# BME STUDENT AMBASSADORS SCHEME 2025-26

#### What is the BME Student Ambassadors Scheme?

The BME Student Ambassadors Scheme aims to nurture peer connections between junior and senior students. Under this scheme, a variety of student-oriented activities/events such as study activities and social gatherings are organized with the involvement of both academic staff and BME buddies.

- To promote BME programme at official events, e.g. Orientation Day;
- To provide academic as well as non-academic support to newly recruited students;
- To serve as an interface between academic staff and junior students;
- To give feedback about the scheme to the department.
